

Dear Friends,

The Institute of Philosophy has now agreed to co-sponsorship/organization of the Intl. Symposium Bildung & Paideia, along with the Plato Society of Zagreb and the Hegel Society of Zadar. The City of Hvar has accepted official patronage of the symposium and will provide the Gradska Loggia to us free of charge for the duration of the conference. Further negotiations will be underway this week.

We thank you for your patience while we renegotiated the dates of the symposium. The final dates for the conference are: October 13-16, with October 12 planned for arrival of participants and October 17 for departure, to take account of ferry connections to the island.

Enclosed please find the draft Call for Papers. At this time, I would like to ask you to submit an abstract for your paper. The official deadline for abstracts will be March 1, but for purposes of our funding applications it would be a great help to us to have your abstract sooner. As mentioned in our earlier message, we kindly request you to consider possible sources of funding you might apply to in your home country or institution. This will definitely assist us in allocation of available resources to other needs (eg. to cover costs for example of student participants who are unable to apply for funding and for the cultural program of the conference).

Please let us know if your arrival or departure dates will differ from the dates named above. This will help us in our general planning and scheduling of the conference lectures and cultural events.
